

LIMITED WARRANTY

Your appliance is protected by a limited warranty for a period of 1 year from the original date of purchase. This warranty covers parts and labor. This warranty is only applicable when appliance is used under normal, personal, family or household use. Ready access to the rear and top of unit, for servicing, is the sole responsibility of the consumer/ owner. There is no warranty for machines operated for commercial or industrial use.

This warranty is subject to the following conditions:

- The appliance has been installed and operated correctly as per manufacturer's directions.
- The appliance is being supplied by the proper electrical voltage.
- The appliance has been used for normal domestic purpose only.
- The appliance has not been serviced, altered, dismantled or otherwise interfered with by any person not authorized by Malber Distribution Corp.

The warranty does not cover the following parts and service:

- Broken door handles
- Ripped or torn door gaskets
- Maintenance related problems e.g. clogged filters, mold condition
- Broken plastic door cover
- Any and all damage caused by failure to remove shipping spacers
- Plumbing related problems

Malber Distribution Corp. reserves the right to deny a claim for warranty repair if it is deemed that the cause of the repair was inflicted by misuse e.g. over soaping, abuse, accidents, improper usage, vermin, fire or flood damage or product failure due to acts of God. The costs of repair or replacement under these excluded circumstances are the responsibility of the consumer/owner.

Machines purchased outside of the Manufacturer's Service Area

The Manufacturer's Service Area is defined as any location that is within 40 miles of New York City and all of Nassau and Suffolk counties. Any appliance that is not within the Manufacturer's Service Area will have a 1 year from the original date of purchase warranty on parts only, unless otherwise stated by Malber Distribution Corp. The customer is responsible at their own expense to have a qualified technician remove the defective part. Customer is liable for any damage incurred during the removal of the part. The defective part must be returned for credit.

This warranty gives you specific legal rights, and you may also have other rights which vary from state to state.
